

## ***Town of Fairfield Engineering Department***

### ***Working in public ROW Requirements***

March 19, 2020

Permits are required for certain work performed in a public right of way. This work includes but is not limited to:

- Driveway Aprons (Processed in Engineering and \$ 30 fee)
- Sidewalks (See also Sewer Dept. for Street Opening Permit\*)
- Curbs (See also Sewer Dept. for Street Opening Permit\*)
- Storm Drainage in Street (See also Sewer Dept. for Street Opening Permit\*)
- Tying into back of Catch Basin (See also Sewer Dept. for Street Opening Permit\*)

A Street Opening/Encroachment Permit (\$ 100 fee in most cases) will be required for **any and all** work performed within the public right of way with exception of Driveway Apron permits which are processed at Engineering (see above). \*All other work in the road (Sidewalks, Curbs, Storm Drainage in Street, etc.) will require Engineering Dept. notification/inspection and a Street Opening/Encroachment Permit issued by the Sewer Department.
