From the Fairfield Tax Assessor's Office Veterans/Military Exemptions

Combat-era veterans or their surviving spouses who have filed their DD-214 (Honorable Discharge) with the Town Clerk may be eligible for an assessment exemption on their dwelling or vehicle. The veteran must have served at least 90 days during a certified combat era. His/her DD-214 or a certified copy must be filed with the Town Clerk by September 30 in order for the exemption to be applied to the next assessment list. In order to qualify, an applicant must file between February 1 and October 1 for the exemption to be applied to the next assessment year's taxes. Proof of income must be submitted at the time of application. In addition, the original or certified copy of the veteran's DD-214 must be on file in the Town Clerk's Office by the prior September 30.
