To dispose of medications at home follow these steps:

Step 1: Keep medication in original container and remove your personal information from the label.

Step 2: Modify you medication by adding a substance like coffee grounds or water. For liquid substances add strong spices or ashes.

Step 3: Conceal the medication by duct taping the bottle.

Step 4: Place the bottle in a nontransparent container (brown paper bag) and secure with duct tape.

Step 5: Dispose of the container in your garbage receptacle. Do not put the container in your recycling bin.
