What is "legal" in Connecticut?

Permitted:



Sparklers

(wire or stick coated with pyrotechnic composition that produces a shower of sparks upon ignition)



Fountains

(any cardboard or heavy paper cone or cylindrical tube containing pyrotechnic mixture that upon ignition produces a shower of colored sparks or smoke – but NOT flames)

containing not more than 100 grams of pyrotechnic mixture per item or 200 grams where more than one fountain is mounted on a common base)

Minimum Age to: Use, Sell, Purchase – – 16 yrs

NOT Permitted:

(without proper license & permit from State Fire Marshal)

All other "Fireworks" Including any



- *explosive device* such as firecrackers, cherry bombs, M-80's, party poppers and snappers.

- *aerial devices* such as skyrockets, roman candles, bottle rockets, mortar launched shells

- *novelties* such as smoke bombs, snakes, glowworms.
