Thank you for your participation in the Fairfield Tree Planting Program.

This program\* aims to plant a variety of trees of varying species, heights, etc., which provide shade and biodiversity, attract birds and other wildlife, and create a healthy environment. When selecting a tree for a location we consider a tree’s full height at maturity in order to situate trees properly so they will thrive and not outgrow the allotted space. Trees offered in the program change due to availability and to maintain diversity. We tag each tree with a unique identifier and geolocation to enable us to follow the tree and record data related to its performance.

Together we have selected and will plant the following tree(s) where staked within the right-of-way area along the roadside of your property.

Feel free to look up this species online at [www.fairfieldct.org/treeplanting](http://www.fairfieldct.org/treeplanting). Keep in mind we will plant a tree that is usually 1-½” to 2” in diameter, which is generally 5 to 10 years old. Sizes will vary depending on species and availability from the nursery.

Your payment signifies your approval to plant and maintain the aforementioned tree(s). If you have any questions about the staked location, please email us. The trees are planted in the spring and fall planting cycles. There are no warranties or guarantees on trees in this program for any reason. That includes deer or mechanical damage, drought, too much or too little water or even storms.

Once the tree is planted, you agree to regularly water and annually mulch it for the first two years and thereafter as needed. Properly established and cared for, this tree should beautify your property for many years to come.
