

## The Great Bulb Exchange is Coming to Fairfield!

Residents of Fairfield are invited to join First Selectman Michael C. Tetreau and take control of their energy future by trading in their old incandescent light bulbs for high-efficiency LED counterparts. This town-wide initiative is focused on reducing energy usage, saving members of the Fairfield community money. Come meet your elected official at the event while exchanging your light bulbs.

To participate in the exchange, residents must present either the postcard they received in the mail outlining the event or a driver's license to validate their address. Limit 2 light bulbs per household.



### Why LED light bulbs?

One LED light bulb can last up to 25 times longer and uses about 80% less electricity than an old-fashioned incandescent light bulb. This simple switch is an easy way to reduce energy use in the home heading into the darker fall months.
