**APPLICANTS MUST SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING:**

1. \$300 Non-Refundable Payment (*check or credit card, no business checks*) \*
  2. Valid Trailer Registration
  3. CT Driver's License
- \*Credit Cards may be processed in the office or over the phone once application has been received

Permits will be issued on a "first come, first served" basis.

- Trailers may be stored in designated spaces between May 17, 2021 and September 30, 2021
- Maximum trailer length 28 feet
- Trailers must display valid Sumer Trailer Storage Permit
- Owners may access and use trailers at their discretion
- Storing of vessels on trailers is prohibited
- Trailers that are not displaying Summer Storage Permits or left in the parking lot on October 1, 2021 will be towed at the owner's expense.

**\* 28' MAXIMUM TRAILER LENGTH, TRAILER STORAGE BOATS MUST PARK IN ASSIGNED SPACE**

I understand the privilege of using the Town's Storage facilities is in the nature of a license and is not to be construed as creating a bailment relationship. I further AGREE TO VOLUNTARILY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISKS OF LOSS, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, that may be sustained by me, or any loss or damage to property owned by me, as a result of being allowed to store my trailer at the marina, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE TOWN, THIRD PARTIES or otherwise.

## **South Benson Marina Summer Trailer Storage Rules and Regulations**

1. The word “marina” is used here to indicate South Benson Marina, Town of Fairfield, CT. The word “Captain” is used here to indicate the owner, the operator of the vessel, the owner’s or operator’s agents, guest, employees, and personal representatives.
2. Storage charges must be paid in advance to cover a full season. No pro-rated or proportional reimbursement for unused storage will be made after the beginning of the season. There will be no reimbursements for any unused summer storage.
3. Storage is for boat trailers only, no other types of trailers will be stored in the marina, i.e. cargo trailers or flatbed trailers.
4. Maximum boat trailer length is 28 feet.
5. Summer trailer storage runs from May 17, 2021 to September 30, 2021.
6. The Captain must provide payment, required documentation and proof of residency prior to receiving Summer Storage permit.
7. The storing of a vessel or other items on the trailer is prohibited during the summer storage season.
8. The Captain is permitted to remove the trailer from designated space at his/her discretion during the summer.
9. The Captain agrees that a trailer stored at the Marina beyond the date agreed upon on this contract without the express written permission of the Marina through a new storage contract shall be considered an abandoned vessel per Connecticut State Statutes Section 14 Title 150.
10. Trailers must display a valid summer storage permit. The Captain’s name may be written on the trailer to aide in identifying the trailer.
11. Trailers without valid/current 2020 Summer Storage Permit will be removed at the owner’s expense.
12. The Captain is responsible for checking their trailer periodically during the season.
13. The Marina is not responsible for damage, loss or theft of trailer.
14. The Captain shall be solely responsible for the safety of their trailer.
15. Summer storage spaces are assigned. Captains will park their trailer only where directed and within the confines of their assigned space.
16. The Marina may move the trailer if deemed necessary.
17. Captains shall provide a valid phone number and email where they may be contacted in the event of an emergency.
18. Failure to comply by these rules will cause the removal of the trailer at the owner’s expense.
