Subject: RE: Question on paving

To all,

The cost of paving is roughly between \$180,000 and \$210,000 per mile. The town has approximately 272 miles of road. The town needs to pave roughly 13 miles of road per year to keep with a 20 year paving cycle which is the best case scenario for the lifespan of asphalt. The administrative time and costs it takes to setup the annual paving program is roughly the same regardless of how many miles of roads the town paves in any particular year. To go through the administrative process of setting up only enough paving for 5 miles of road would be cost prohibitive from both an administrative and contractor mobilization standpoint and could drive our costs higher.

Regarding the restoration of roads after planned utility improvements/upgrades, the town works out a cost sharing agreement with the utilities for restoration based on the age and condition of each of the roads prior to issuing road opening permits. If the road needs to be completely repaved after the utility work is completed, generally the Town bears 1/2 the cost for repaving. In the case of the recent water main and gas main upgrade on Fairfield Beach Road, the Town will be receiving 1/2 the cost of pavement restoration for repaving which is slated to be completed in June 2020.
