**Subject:** Transportation and another concern

Jim

I spoke with Colleen Deasy and Doreen Munsell today for an update on the transportation savings for 19-20. There is an expectation that we will receive more funds but we are not sure of that exact amount yet. I will get that to you as soon as possible.

A number of towns are negotiating with the bus companies to apply the additional funds towards the 20-21 budget as a credit. That has been the recommendation of our attorney. Again, as soon as I have that I will get it to you.

One additional potential cost has emerged this morning. Given the effort to ramp up contract tracing we believe we will have more staff who may be required to self-quarantine for 14 days. This potentially impacts our sub account. It would be difficult to put a number on this but it is a concern and I wanted you and the Board to be aware. Every time we play out the scenario additional issues arise.
